Hands off! More reason to avoid physical discipline: Two new studies (both followed children from ages 5 through high school) show that kids who were spanked or slapped during their school years were more likely to have behavior problems as teens—and do things like steal or act aggressively toward their peers.

No more nit picking Soon you may be able to kill nasty head lice faster, according to a study in *Pediatrics*. With often only one application and no labor-intensive combing for leftover nits, a new spinosad-based cream rinse was substantially more effective than traditional treatments. (Both are pesticides, but spinosad is believed to be less toxic.) The new treatment, to be sold as Natrova, is expected to be approved by the FDA in 2010.

Healthy-up after-school care Students in after-school-care programs are typically active for about 20 minutes each day, researchers at Kansas State University found. But when the program leaders were trained to include more physical fun, heavier kids caught up to their leaner peers in activity level. And it doesn't take gym class-like intensity: Free play is the best way to get kids moving more, they noted.
